From the desk of Pastor Ron Mellor

Have you ever heard of something called a polar bear plunge? According to Wikipedia "A polar bear plunge is an event held during the winter where participants enter a body of water despite the very low temperature." These crazy happenings are usually held on New Year's Day.

The largest of the polar bear plunges takes place at Scheveningen, the Netherlands' main beach resort town. More than 10,000 people dive collectively into that icy-cold sea water!

The "Plungapalooza" event in Maryland, is the largest polar bear plunge in the United States. It is held annually at the Sandy Point State Park.

Sponsored by the Maryland State Police, it raises funds for a very good cause, the Special Olympics. They routinely have some 7,500 crazies who jump into frigid waters.

Just over 30 years ago, on January 1, 1987, I participated in a polar bear plunge event. It took place in Chico, California, in a large pool in Bidwell Park. I remember that the air temperature had been very cold, starting out even below 30 degrees. The plunge officials told us that the water temperature was 39 degrees. Yikes! There were probably 60-70 of us who were poised on the side of the pool waiting for the starter's pistol to fire. After the gun went off, all I can remember is jumping in and I could hardly breathe as the cold water instantly took my breath away.

I was suddenly numb and all I could think about was getting to the other side and getting out. I did survive this plunge, but have never felt the need to have to do it again!

Matthew 24:12 speaks of how in the days before Jesus returns that people's hearts will grow cold as their love toward God and people will significantly decline. In a certain symbolical sense, all of society today is involved in a "polar bear plunge," as people's hearts of love have gotten cold. Cold toward a vibrant, on fire relationship with God. Cold in relationship to the "Bride of Christ," the church. Cold toward people, and the salvation of the spiritually lost.

We are in desperate need of a spiritual warming. May the Spirit of God set a fire that melts our cold, hard hearts!

I would suggest that a good prayer or each of us to put into practice in our lives would be the lyrics from Keith Green's song, "O Lord, You're Beautiful." The second verse goes like this:

O Lord, please light the fire, That once burned bright and clear. Replace the lamp of my first love; That burns with holy fear!


