From the desk of Pastor Ron Mellor

We are presently in a message series called "The Power of Everyone." The Bible repeatedly maintains that we as believers should come together in unity and work toward a common goal. We can accomplish so much more together than we can divided. As the old saying goes: "United we stand, divided we fall."

In his 2013 bestselling book, *The Boys in the Boat,* author Daniel Brown tells the story of the 8-person rowing team from the University of Washington. Quite unexpectedly, they won the gold medal at the 1936 Summer Olympics held in Berlin, Germany.

The Boys in the Boat gives a detailed account about their preparation for the Olympics and their incredible teamwork. Of particular interest from this Gold Medal winning rowing team was a small, unathletic member of the team. Only 5'4", this rowing team member served as what is known as the "coxswain." His role was to sit at the back of the boat to be in charge of coordinating the power and rhythm of the oars of the rowers. Even though a coxswain does not have an oar, and therefore not actually contributing to the act of propelling the boat forward, he or she is an essential member of a rowing team.



Jesus served as the disciples' coxswain. For over 3 years, Christ coached His disciples how to work together as a team. It was only after He died, was resurrected and went back to heaven that the disciples began to function as an effective Kingdom team. And when they did function well as a team, they overcame large odds and made incredible advances for the Kingdom.

These common men (some of them were even boat guys!) worked together with the Spirit's power to give birth to and grow the Christian faith.

Here is Paul's description of a successful Christian team: "He makes the whole body fit together perfectly. As each part does its own special work, it helps the other parts grow, so that the whole body is healthy and growing and full of love." Ephesians 4:16 NLT



FAKE NEWS OR REAL NEWS?

PROPAGANDA IS NOW LEGAL FOR THE U.S. GOVERNMENT TO USE ON THE POPULATION OF THE U.S. AS WELL AS THOSE CITIZENS ABROAD.

The National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) is the name for each of a series of United States federal laws specifying the annual budget and expenditures of the U.S. Department of Defense. The first NDAA was passed in 1961.

On 12/29/12, President Obama signed HR 4310, the 2013 NDAA, that authorizes the use of propaganda inside the United States. This version of the National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) includes an amendment that would legalize the use of propaganda on the American public by repealing the Smith-Mundt Act of 1948, that banned government propaganda.

Propaganda that was supposed to target only foreigners can now be aimed at the American people, even through the news media.

A Propaganda Industrial Complex has now been created, funded and used to sell stories to the citizens that are either wholly or in part NOT TRUE, and with their own tax dollars.

This bill appears to not only open the door to legalization of the dissemination of propaganda in America, but would also legalize covert infiltration into media organizations.

Could this be the source of our FAKE NEWS?

We need to pray continually for God to protect us from the evil in our world today.
